In her Master's research project, Tatiana investigated a series of known organometallic catalysts for the synthesis of novel poly(ester-amides). The project focussed on screening several aluminium-based catalysts, along with a wide range of monomers, to provide an optimised ring-opening copolymerisation of N-sulfonyl aziridines and cyclic anhydrides.
